Eligibility:

Applicant must be

- a bachelor's degree student
- enrolled as a full-time student at his/her home university during the exchange period
- able to communicate in English
- interested in learning Thai culture
- good at interpersonal skills

Required application documents:

- 1. NU CEPT Application Form (Application form in Part 6 has to be completed by the university approval of International Office/ Department / Faculty from home university.
- 2. Certificate of university enrollment
- 3. A copy of passport valid for at least 6 months prior to the program commencement (if any)
- 4. A full coverage overseas travel insurance which can be submitted after receiving official announcement



Required performances:

The participants are required to present and perform your own culture for the two activities as follows: 1) 26 February 2026 "Internationalization at Home" 2) 27 February 2026 "Farewell Party"



Each applicant will be confirmed by NU official announcement via email by 24 November 2025.

After the application deadline, successful applicants will be notified of the details for program fee payment. *Bank transfer charges must be borne by applicants.
