Study Abroad: Who? Why? How?

概要

I am here in Morioka with American college students for a semester study-abroad program. Most colleges and universities in the US encourage students to consider studying abroad. In 2022-2023, 1% of all American students took part in a study-abroad program. More than half of them studied in Spain, Italy, the UK, France or Ireland, but new research shows that students are beginning to apply to more programs and to more countries.

What is the situation in Japan? Japan is recruiting more international students, and a recent initiative aims to increase both the number of international students coming to Japan and the number of domestic students studying abroad. Why do only about 30% of Japanese young people express a desire to study abroad, while the number is over 50% in Western countries and South Korea?

In this presentation, I will discuss why students choose to study abroad and the benefits to them and to the institutions, and countries, where they attend. I will focus on current trends, particularly looking at the United States and Japan. I will also discuss important points to consider when preparing for a study abroad program. I aim to end with advice for how to make a study-abroad experience successful.
