IV. Areas of exchange

1) Exchange level

All levels (Bachelor, Master's, and PhD) of inbound exchange students are eligible.
Lecturers in Engineering, Business or Architecture related areas are welcome for teaching mobility at HCMUT.
Non-academic staff (esp. from International Office) from partner universities are welcome for one week mobility.

2) Course information and language of teaching

Courses in English available to exchange students	<p>Course information: https://hcmut.edu.vn/en/study/program?lang=en&tab=1</p> <p>The availability of courses in English varies at different academic levels and majors and depends on each academic calendar. These courses are under 30 international Bachelor and Master programs at HCMUT.</p> <p>If students intend to conduct research, the supervising professor in our available field of study will be willing to communicate in English. In all cases, the admission will be based on the compatibility of the study/research plan written in the Application Form.</p>
Course registration	<p>After consulting with a professor from our faculties, students should select courses from the course catalogue provided to them after being admitted as our Exchange Student.</p> <p>In case of course-attendance, the student is required to select at least 11 credits/semester at HCMUT (equivalent to 22 ECTS)</p>

3) Credit system

One credit is equivalent to 50 hours of standardized learning time for the learner, including the time for scheduled lectures, guided instruction, self-study, research, experiential learning, and assessments/exams.

For classroom teaching activities, one credit requires a minimum of 15 hours of lectures or 30 hours of practical work, experiments, discussions, in which one classroom hour is counted as 50 minutes.

5) Weekly class schedule

The teaching activities are organized between 06:00 and before 22:00 (periods 1 to 16) on all days of the week from Monday to Sunday. The scheduling of other learning activities related to the training program will be based on specific situations or particular academic levels.

6) Types of courses

Classes are generally conducted face-to-face.

Online learning is organized depending on specific situations in accordance with the academic regulations.

All lecturers are required to use “Bach Khoa e-learning – BkeL” (an internal online platform at HCMUT) to facilitate their teaching activities and share course-related materials/documents to students.

3) Visa

<p>Students who stay at HCMUT for academic exchange period are required to obtain a study visa before entering Vietnam, following the procedures below.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. After finalizing and signing a Learning Agreement, HCMUT sends students a visa request form to fill in.2. HCMUT submits all documents of the students’ study period to the Vietnamese Immigration Department for issuing the Visa Approval Letter.3. HCMUT sends the scanned Visa Approval Letter + Acceptance Letter to the students.4. The incoming students bring their original passports and the provided Visa Letter to the expected Vietnamese Embassy/Consulate in their home country to collect the visa. <p><u>Notes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The Visa Approval Letter issued by the Immigration Department will enable the students to obtain a visa shortly.- The incoming students had better NOT apply for a tourist visa before receiving the Visa Approval Letter. A tourist visa doesn’t mean for study purposes and will not be accepted for an exchange stay at HCMUT.

4) Insurance

Before students leave their countries, we strongly recommend that they obtain travel insurance, which covers difficulties, medical helps or incidents during travel from and back to their countries. The students are required to provide a copy of their insurance to HCMUT one week before their arrival.

5) Scholarships

Incoming students from HCMUT’s partners with valid agreements can benefit from tuition waivers. Exchange students can have the opportunity to receive scholarships to partly cover necessary expenses during their mobility period.
