Rules for disposing garbage

Please take your garbage to your designated collection site.

Please dispose your garbage, following the collection schedule.

Take your garbage to the designated collection site by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day. The garbage put out on a wrong collection day or after the collection time will be left uncollected.

Please ensure proper sorting and place garbage in a transparent or semi-transparent plastic bag. The garbage without proper sorting will be left uncollected.

Notice

There is no garbage collection from December 31, 2020 to January 2, 2021 (Plastic containers and packaging will be closed from December 31 to January 3).
