Application Guidelines for the Position at Iwate University, Faculty of Agriculture

Faculty Recruitment for Iwate University (Associate Professor or Assistant Professor (tenure-track))

- 1. Position and Number of Positions: 1 (one) Associate Professor or Assistant Professor (tenure-track*))
 - * For assistant professor: Please note that an interim evaluation will be conducted by the day at which three years have passed from the date of employment, and a tenure review will be conducted seven months prior to the expiration date of the tenure-track faculty member's term. Tenure (assistant professor, without tenure) will be granted if target values required for granting tenure have been met during the term.

In the case of a particularly outstanding evaluation in the interim evaluation, the eligibility for granting tenure may be discussed at that time.

2. Affiliation:

3. Field of specialization and Subjects to teach:

Field of specialization: Agricultural Environmental Engineering and Agricultural Information Engineering-related (field robotics, AI, smart agriculture)
Subjects to teach:

We are looking for a candidate who can be in charge of Agricultural Work Systems, Field Robotics (shared), Outlines of Smart Agriculture (shared), Innovative Agriculture Laboratory III (shared), "Monozukuri" Manufacturing Practicum (shared), Introduction to Innovative Agriculture (shared), Outlines of Rural Environmental Sciences (shared), Applied Mathematics (shared), Food Industry Systems Laboratory I, II (shared), supervision of graduation research, etc. as well as liberal arts subjects such as Agricultural Environmental Engineering (shared) and graduate school subjects.

Iwate University has set a limit on the number of lecture hours that Assistant Professors are allowed to teach. Therefore, if you are hired as an assistant professor, the subjects (lectures, labs, and exercises) that you will actually teach will be determined in consultation after the hiring decision is made. This position is in charge of specialized courses in the Advanced Agriculture and Forestry Program, Regional Industry Course, Department of Regional Development, Graduate School of Integrated Arts and Sciences. In addition, you may also be in charge of general science courses, courses common to all majors, and courses common to all courses. (If hired as an assistant professor, you will not be in charge of lecture courses.)

- (2) Person who has enthusiasm for education and research at Ueda campus of Iwate University
- (3) Person with enough research achievements in the field of specialization as an associate professor or assistant professor of Faculty of Agriculture, Iwate University
- (4) Person who can provide education and research supervision for undergraduate students and graduate students
- (5) Person who can actively contribute to society through research results, contribute to local communities, and provide technical guidance for local governments
- (6) Person who has a sense of cooperation and can actively participate in the management of Undergraduate and Graduate School as a faculty member of Iwate university
- (7) Person with enough language skills (Japanese and English) to perform the above duties
- 5. Starting date: As soon as possible after January 1st, 2026
- 6. Term of employment:
- (1) Associate Professor: Tenure
- (2) Assistant Professor: 5 (five) years

7. Compensation:

Salary and Benefits: Based on the salary regulations of Iwate University and subject to annual salary system (Retirement allowance is paid at the time of retirement.)

Working Hours: Discretionary working system for professional work, 7 hours and 45 minutes of de facto working per day

Insurance: Employment Insurance, Social Insurance, Workers' Accident Compensation Insurance, Mutual Aid Association of the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology

Days off: Saturday, Sunday, public holidays, year-end and New Year holidays, etc.

9. Selection process

Applicants who pass the document screening will be invited for an interview. In this interview, applicants will be asked to introduce the research activities in English. The interview will be conducted in person, while the travel expenses for the interview are the responsibility of the applicant. An online interview may be permitted under certain circumstances.

10. Submission of application documents and inquiries

The following documents must be submitted at the application.

- (1) A full curriculum vitae (with photograph, any format)
- (2) A list of research achievements

 Publications must be labeled as refereed or non-refereed in the list (see attached).
- (3) Five reprints (or copies) of major publications
- (4) Past achievements in research and ambitions for future research (within 2 sheets of A4 paper)
- (5) Past experience in education and ambitions for future education (within 2 sheets of A4 paper)
- (6) A list of acquisition status of external research funds such as Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research, joint research, commissioned research, etc.
- (7) Descriptions of the applicant's experience of technical guidance related to the field of specialization, community contribution activities, and other activities that the applicant

- deems useful for the selection (approximately 1 sheet of A4 paper. Clearly indicate the role of the applicant.)
- (8) Names and contact information (affiliation, address, telephone, and e-mail) of two references

If it is deemed necessary during the selection process, we may ask the applicants to submit additional materials later.
