In response to the COVID-19 crisis, some changes were made to the student selection method for the April 2021 1st Admission to the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences Master's Program, Division of Science and Engineering.

Please note that the student selection method for the April 2021 2nd Admission will be announced on the University's website (<https://www.iwate-u.ac.jp/admission/graduate/info.html>) later based on the judgment made according to the current situation.

The exam method, exam schedule, etc. are subject to further change depending on the situation in the future. Any changes will be announced on the University's website.

○Score Submission

The original requirement was that "TOEIC Listening & Reading Test scores" would be used to evaluate applicants' language skills. Instead, **TOEIC Listening and Reading Test or TOEFL iBT scores** will be used to evaluate applicants' language skills.

Please submit one of the following when apply:

- The original copy of the TOEIC Listening & Reading Test Official Score Certificate
- The original copy of the TOEIC-IP (also known as the College TOEIC) Listening & Reading Test Score Report (individual Score Report)
- The original copy of the TOEFL iBT Official Score Report or Test Taker Score Report
- The original copy of the TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition Official Score Report or Test Taker Score Report

*If you have taken the TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition or TOEFL iBT test at a test center, and are unable to submit the Official Score Report with the other application documents, please download the Test Taker Score Report from "My TOEFL Home" and submit it instead. The Original Score Report should also be submitted once available.

○Score Validity

It was originally stated that "the score to be submitted must have been obtained no earlier than three years prior to the first day of the examination." This has now been changed from three years to **four years**.

○Score Submission

No need to submit TOEIC scores. TOEIC scores will not be used for evaluation even if they are submitted.
